Arthur Wint Centenary Scholarship Application form

Section A: Introduction

Arthur Wint is the first Jamaican to win an Olympic gold medal in the 1948 Games in Manchester England. His early athletic years were rewarded with success as he won gold in the 1938 PanAm Games. Wint has also served the medical fraternities of Britain and Jamaica and also served as Jamaica's High Commissioner to Britain. His name today is one of the greatest Jamaican names known internationally and Jamaica can truly boast that Arthur Wint is a true son of the soil. In an effort to honour the memory of this great man also known as the "Gentle Giant", the Ministry of Culture, Gender, Entertainment and Sport and GC Foster College for Physical Education and Sport wish to initiate the Arthur Wint Centenary Scholarship. The Scholarship will honour the legacy of Arthur Wint and facilitate the success of future sportsmen and women.

Section B: Instructions

Potential candidates are required to read the following document carefully before completing the attached application form.

Application forms must be accompanied with the following documents:

- 1. Certified copies of birth certificates
- 2. Certified copies of examination results such as CSEC, CAPE
- 3. Certified copies of transcripts from the previous academic year/s at the GC Foster College or similar educational institution
- 4. Proof of achievements in sport
- 5. Three references (one (1) character reference, two (2) academic references)
- 6. An essay in no more than 2500 words explaining how your course of studies can contribute to National development.

Section C: Requirements

- 1. Candidates must be registered fulltime in a three or four year under graduate degree programme
- Candidate must have a history of representational participation on sports at the secondary school level
- 3. He or she must have performed satisfactorily at the junior and/ or senior level in local or international competition
- 4. He/ she should have attained a position of first, second or third place in competition

- 5. Candidate should be a member of a club or organisation geared towards sports participation
- 6. Candidates must display outstanding academic achievement by maintaining an average of 80% or A average
- 7. Candidate must have experience in volunteerism
- 8. He/ she must show outstanding levels of responsibility in his/ her community
- 9. He/ she must demonstrate leadership qualities

Requirements for Applicants/ Candidates

- 1. Applicants must be a duly registered full-time student
- 2. Applicant must have a GPA of 3.0 or above
- 3. Must provide their transcript for the previous year
- 4. Must provide one (1) character reference
- 5. Must provide two (2) academic references (one must be from a lecturer of the GC Foster College)
- 6. Must agree to participate in initiatives and programmes organized by the GC Foster College and the Ministry of Culture Gender Entertainment and Sport that are aimed at promoting the work of the institution, the Ministry and the legacy of Arthur Wint.
- 7. All shortlisted applicants must be prepared to participate in an interview
- 8. Must not have a criminal record

SECTION D: Collection and submission of forms.

This application form should be collected from and submitted to the Ministry to Culture, Gender, Entertainment and Sport (Sports Monitoring and Development Division at 4 Trafalgar Road, Kingston 5).

- 1. Applications should be prepared and delivered to the Ministry of Culture Gender Entertainment & Sport no later than November 30, 2020 at 12:00 noon.
- 2. Applications without accompanying requirements will not be considered eligible
- 3. Applicants must ensure they collect and save their submission receipt form for their records
- 4. Applicants should make themselves available for interviews

The Arthur Wint Scholarship Committee reserves the right to make shortlist and interview eligible applicants and to make the final decision on recipients.
